Laboratory Testing:

- Select labs are drawn in the clinic and sent to our local laboratory
- Tests with immediate results during your visit includes:
 - COVID-19
 - Glucose
 - Lipid panel (cholesterol, triglycerides)
 - Mononucleosis
 - Pregnancy
 - Strep throat
 - Urinalysis
